P7 Transition 2022

As we begin the summer term, we are looking forward to our P7 learners joining us at Portobello High School in August. Whilst this is often a very exciting time for our young people, we are mindful that it can also be little unsettling and so we hope that the information detailed below will offer some reassurance.

Work has been ongoing between Portobello High School and our associate primary schools for some time now and we want you to know that, collectively, we're doing everything we can to ensure as smooth a transition as possible for your child.

We are delighted that for the first time in what feels like a very long time, we are able to run a 3-day in-person P7 transition visit. This will take place from Tuesday 14 - Thursday 16 June. During this visit your child will get to experience some lessons within our school, meet their class and generally get a feel for life at Portobello High School.

To support the P7 transition process this year, I am attaching a link to a short Microsoft Form for your child to complete which contains two sections detailed below. Please ensure your child completes this by Monday 2nd May.

Section 1 – Peer Group

This section will give your child the opportunity to identify 6 pupils that they feel they would work well with at Portobello High School. We will then use this information, alongside the information from the primary school, to make sure your child is placed into a class with at least one of their nominated friends. Please note the pupils your child identifies do not have to be in the same primary class or even the same primary school.

Section 2 – Sibling Check

Please let us know if your child has a brother or sister currently attending Portobello High School and which house they belong to i.e. Abercorn, Brunstane, Crichton or Duddingston.

Finally, we plan to hold a Parent Information Evening on 9th June from 6pm – 7:15pm. This will be an opportunity for parents and carers to meet some of the Senior Leadership Team and Support Team and to find out a little bit more about S1 at Portobello High School. Due to the capacity limitations of our main hall and the size of the S1 year group, the evening will be restricted to parents and carers only. The deadline for questions is the end of the school day on Friday 27 May.
